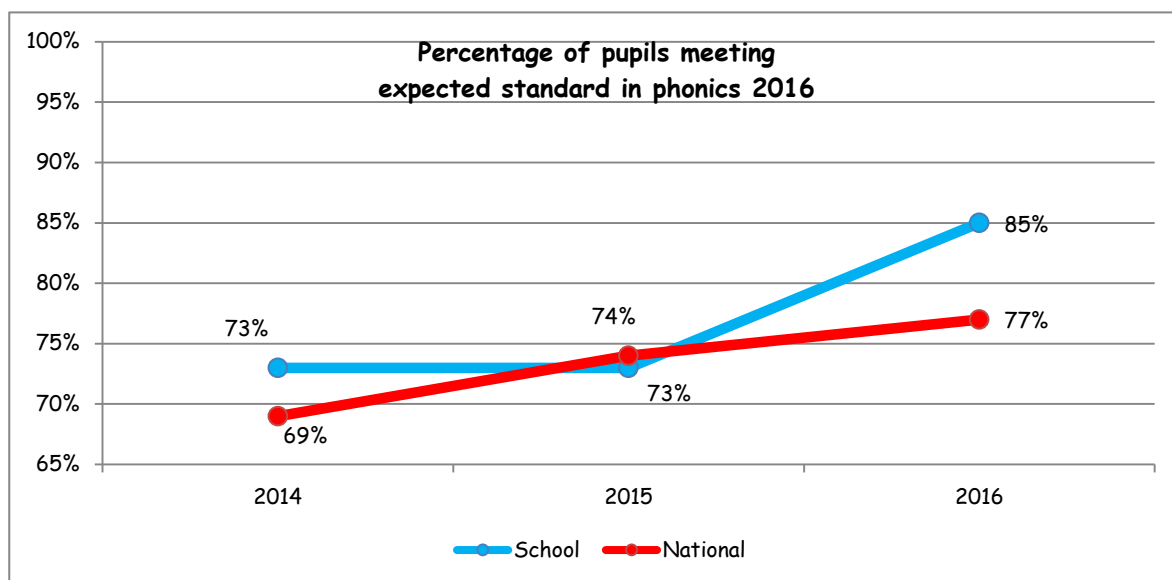


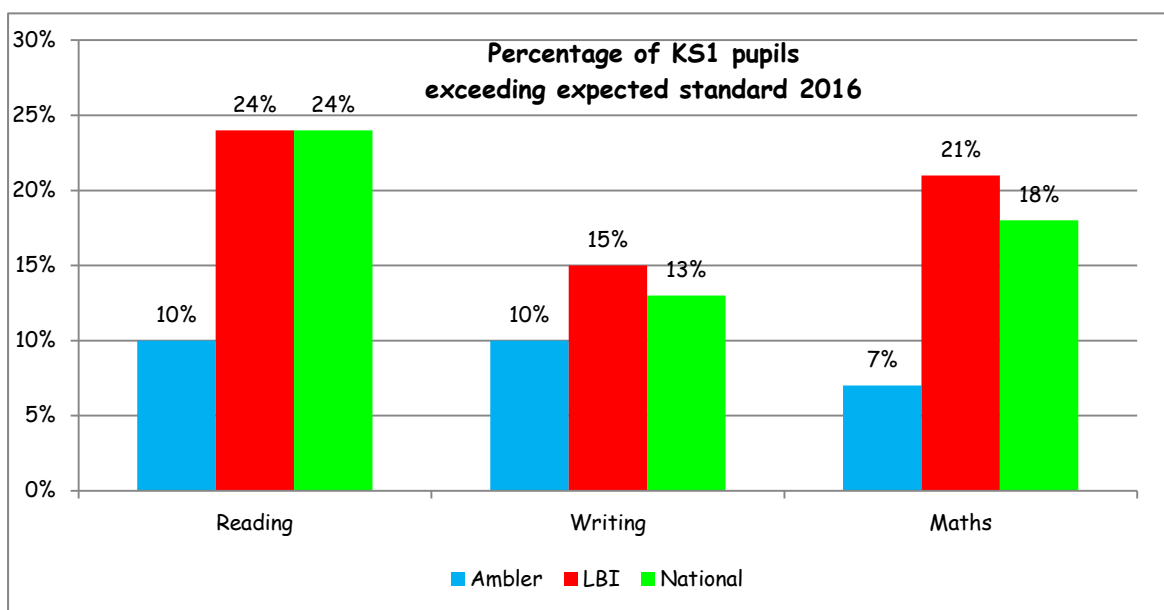
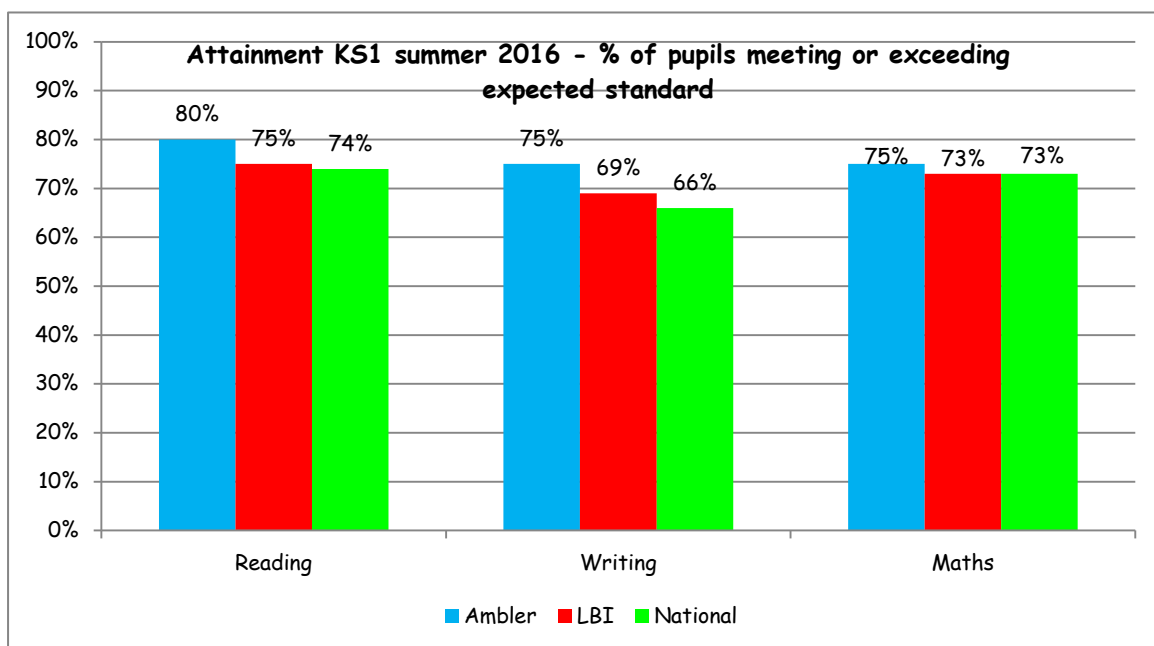
In all previous years, the school was judged on the proportion of pupils attaining a L2C+ in year 2 and a 4C+ in year 6. Given the changes in the curriculum and the new, more challenging age related expectations pupils are now considered to have met the required standard if they perform roughly in line with an 'old' 2b or 4b. In order to have some comparative data to support our understanding of 'trends' the brackets show the percentage of pupils at 2b+ and 4b+ in previous years. This year's data shows the proportion of pupils meeting or exceeding the required standard.

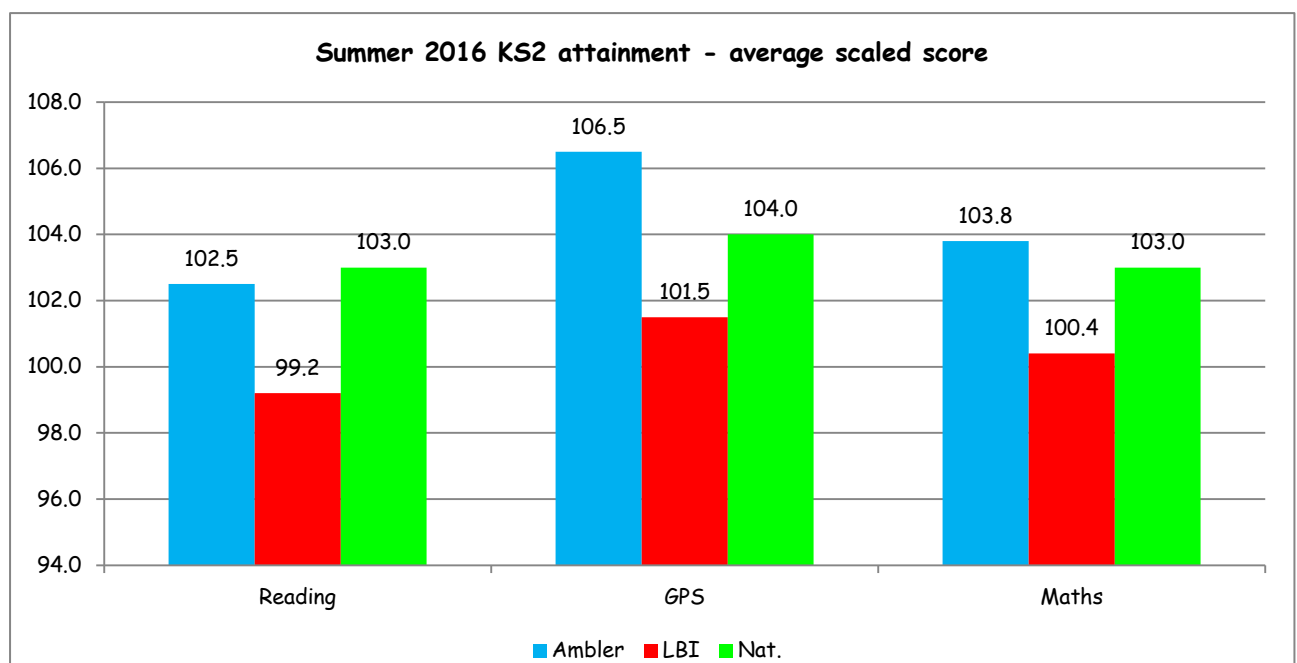
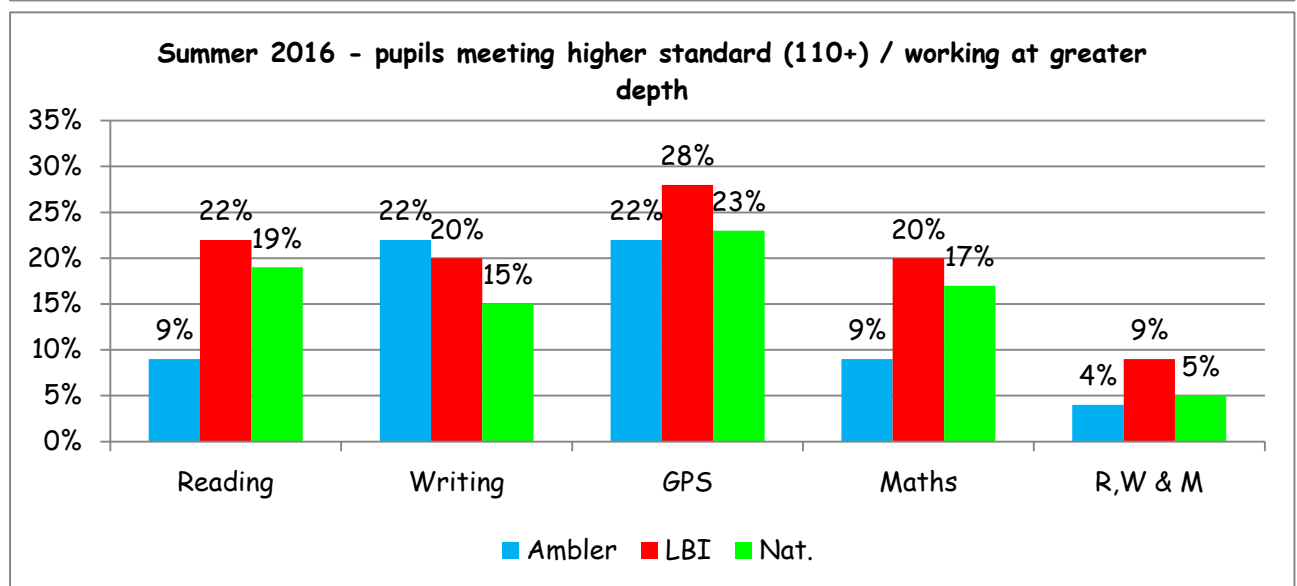
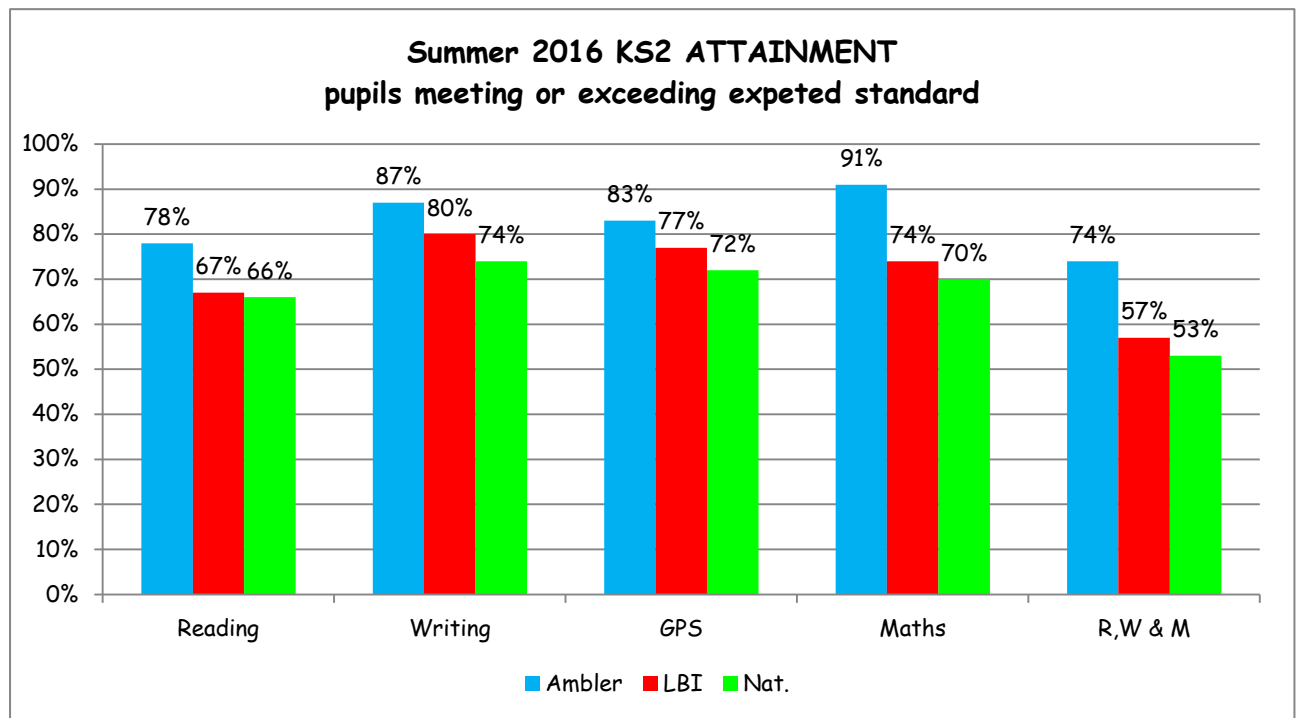
