As part of our history curriculum, Year 6 will be visiting the Churchill War Rooms on **Tuesday 21st January 2020**.

On the day, we will be travelling to and from the war rooms by public transport. We will be leaving school promptly at 9:30am and will be back at lunchtime.

The children will be provided with a packed lunch however, if you wish to supplement the school's packed lunch, please feel free to do so with a healthy sandwich or piece of fruit and a drink (**no fizzy drinks, chocolate, sweets, sharing bags of crisps or biscuits or chewing gum**). We are a nut-free environment so please do not bring any food that contains nuts. Please make sure that your child also has a re-fillable bottle of water as water is no longer provided with the school lunch as we are trying to reduce our use of one-use plastics. The children have all been given an Ambler reusable water bottle.

Please ensure that your child is wearing full school uniform (including an Ambler jumper or cardigan) and has a suitable coat and shoes as it is likely to be cold and/or wet. We will be walking for part of our journey whatever the weather!

If your child has any medical conditions (including asthma), please ensure that they have any medication in school that they may require and that it is in date otherwise they will not be able to come on the trip.
