FAQs

What is Movie Night?

For three nights only Ambler's lower hall is transformed into an exclusive 5 star kids-only movie theatre! The children have voted on which film they want to watch and can settle down in their poshest PJs for an exclusive big(ish) screen experience. (Movies will be age appropriate)

When is the Movie Night?

3.30 – 5.30pm on Tues 11th Feb for Reception children and their parents or carers, Wednesday 12th February for Key Stage 1 children (unaccompanied), and Thursday 13th February for Key Stage 2 (unaccompanied).

How much does it cost?

Should I send my child with a snack?

Children will be given a snack (pop corn and a drink of water) before the film but you are welcome to provide an additional (NUT FREE) snack for them to eat as well. All snacks must be eaten before the movie, not during (No food allowed in the auditorium!)

What about clubs?

If your child is booked into a club or play-as-you-go on Weds 12th (KS1) or Thurs 13th (KS2), they will be taken to the Movie Night instead. Extended day will run as usual after the movie finishes, children who have a place at extended day will be taken from the Movie Night to the Lodge. If you need to pick up your child after 5.30pm please ensure you have booked a place at extended day (this can be done via the School Gateway app, or contact the office).

Reception children need to be accompanied by an adult, but you can share this responsibility with other parents. Sorry no siblings.

Where should I collect my child from?

Children should be collected after the Movie from their normal morning drop-off KS1 or KS2 playgrounds at 5.30pm. Children attending extended day should be collected from the Lodge as usual.

And the Pyjama thing?

Please make sure your child comes to school in their uniform as usual. Children will be allowed to change into their PJs (if they wish) in the classroom once the school day has ended.

What if my child doesn't want to come?

No problem, this is just for fun. You can collect your child as usual after school.
