

Dear Parents/Carers,

As part of our Science topic, Living Things and their Habitats, Year 5 will be visiting Kew Garden on **Tuesday, 17th March 2020**. The children will have hands-on experience in observing living plants and become 'Kew Horticulturalists', as well as investigate the journey and life cycle of a seed through to flowering. They will also have time in the Children's Garden, where over 100 mature trees spread over this beautiful landscape, with hidden treasures and adventures around every corner, leading to a 4m high canopy walk wrapped around a 200-year-old oak tree.

On the day, we will be travelling to and from the venue by public transport and will arrive back in time for the usual pick-up at 3.30pm.

Packed lunch from school will be provided and we will be eating at the venue. Please ensure your child has a small bag to carry their lunch in (e.g. a drawstring bag or small rucksack). If you wish to supplement the school's packed lunch, please feel free to do so with a water bottle, a healthy sandwich or piece of fruit (NO fizzy drinks, chocolate, sweets, large bags of crisps or chewing gum). Please also ensure that there are **no nuts**.

Please ensure that your child is wearing full school uniform and has a weather appropriate coat. No money should be brought on the trip.

The cost of the trip is **£2 per child** (with £5 being subsidised courtesy of Friends of Ambler). Please make payment on the app or speak to the front office about how you can pay in an alternative way.

Please give consent by replying to this email, answering on the app or returning a signed copy no later than **Friday, 13th March 2020**. If any parents/carers would like to help, please feel free to speak to the class teachers or show interest on the form below.
