Year 4 will be visiting the British Museum, on **Monday 16th March**. They will be attending an interactive presentation on 'mummification', as well as exploring the museum and its exhibitions. This is an exciting opportunity for the children to see some real Ancient Egyptian artefacts and learn more about the fascinating ritual of mummification. The cost of the workshop has been covered by Friends of Ambler so the whole visit will be free of charge.

The children will all receive a packed lunch from the school, however you may wish to provide your child with additional snacks (no nuts or fizzy drinks). This trip will go ahead whatever the weather, therefore please dress your child appropriately. If it is forecast to rain please provide a suitable jacket.
