COMMUNICATION, LANGUAGE AND LITERACY

Contemporary Fiction & Story Writing: The Snail and the Whale

Non Fiction: Lists and Captions

Poetry: Poems about the senses and rhyming couplets.

Phonics: The children have daily phonics sessions of 25mins with a year 1 teacher. They work in small groups according to their current understanding of phonics.



MATHEMATICAL DEVELOPMENT

Children will be using concrete resources such as counters or cubes alongside pictures to help with their counting and number recognition.



- Counting, number recognition and ordering numbers. *At first we will be focusing on counting to 20 confidently forwards and backwards*
- One more and one less of a number. *Eg. 4 is one more than 3*
- Addition and Subtraction
- Securing number facts such as number bonds to 10. *Eg 5+5 = 10*

How to support your child at home with Year 1 Work.

- Make sure your child reads to an adult every day and this is recorded in their school reading diary
- Helping to create and check shopping lists
- Writing diaries of weekends, trips and school holidays
- Spot new and common words out and about; in the car for instance
- Revising sounds and tricky words
- Playing spelling games
- Spotting 3D shapes
- Developing fine motor skills e.g. cutting and sticking, painting, junk modelling
- Reading a range of books relating to our topics and reciting them
- Sharing a storybook

Any opportunity whilst out and about can lead to a learning experience!

TOPIC: ALL ABOUT ME!



SCIENCE:

In science we will be looking at the features of humans and animals. We will also be looking at what these body parts do and study our senses. In the second half of the Autumn Term the children will be studying materials.

DESIGN and TECHNOLOGY:

We will continue to follow food safety and hygiene rules. We will prepare dishes using principles of a healthy diet and learn where food comes from.

ART:

As artists we will create collages in the style of Henri Matisse. We will also be looking at portraits in the style of Andy Warhol.

GEOGRAPHY:

In geography we will be learning the continents and learning a continents song! Linking with our science topic of animals, we will also be looking at where different animals come from and why.

HISTORY:

As historians we will be learning about British nurse Mary Seacole as part of Black History Month.

P.E:

The children have 2 PE sessions per week, one with PE coaches Matt and Chris on Monday. The children we will be practising their ball skills and dance skills. Please leave your PE kit in school all week, as it will be sent home at half term.

ICT:

In ICT we will be learning about how to use a computer safely.

DRAMA:

We will be starting drama for the first time and having this on a Monday afternoon alongside PE. This will be linked to our literacy topics and PSHE!
