How to support your child at home with Year 1 Work.

Any opportunity whilst out and about can lead to a learning experience:

- Helping to create and check shopping lists, writing diaries of weekends, trips and school holidays
- Spot new and common words out and about; in the car for instance
- Play games of I spy, hangman, common word bingo
- Counting objects on and back
- Spotting 3D shapes
- Developing fine motor skills e.g. cutting and sticking, painting, junk modelling
- Listening games such as 'Simon Says'
- Memory games such as removing objects (Kim's game)
- Reading non-fiction books relating to our topics or sharing a story book

THE CREATIVE LEARNING JOURNEY:

TOPICS: All About Our World & Food Glorious Food

SCIENCE In science we will be continuing our investigations of materials we will explore compare and test different materials. After half term we will be growing plants. We will name some common plants. Identify the parts of a plant. Understand that plants are living and recognise what plants need to grow. We will plant both veg and flowers in the school garden.

GEOGRAPHY As geographers we will use maps and globes to investigate food from around the world. We will compare and contrast locations. Children will make their own map to show their route to school.

HISTORY As historians we will be learning about George Stephenson who built the first public inter-city railway line for steam trains.

P.E As athletes we will be practising our ball, team games skill, gymnastics and dance.

ART: Children will learn paper mache techniques and will be making their own fruits for a healthy fruit bowl.

ICT: In ICT we will get the foundations ready for coding by teaching the children to give instructions orally and write them down.

MUSIC:

This term in music Year 1 will be learning songs about food. Through this they will improve their singing skills, and practise performing the songs that they have learnt. They will use percussion instruments to accompany their singing, and they will even have a go at composing their own songs.
